

Element 3: Clinical summaries are provided to patients for more than 50 percent of office visits within three business days

PCC EHR practices that have been registered to use PCC's patient portal functionality, My Kid's Chart, have the ability to give patients portal access. Since PCC EHR automatically sends clinical summaries to the portal *instantly* after patients are seen, all patients with portal access will automatically qualify in the numerator for this measure if they were seen by the selected provider in the reporting period used.
