

Factor 4: Generate lists of patients who are on specific medications and pro-actively remind these patients/families and clinicians of services needed.

The “Patient Lists” functionality in PCC EHR can be used to identify patients who have been prescribed one or more medications in a specified time period.

The following example is a patient list created to identify patients given a prescription for ADHD medication in the past three months. Such a list could be used to identify patients who had recently started a new ADHD medication that you will want to follow up:

A patient list based on medication could also be useful for identifying patients to contact regarding a medication recall or patients prescribed a brand name drug versus a generic.
