
Factor 7 – Demonstrates the capability for electronic exchange of key clinical information with clinicians in facilities

As a Meaningful Use 2011 certified vendor, PCC EHR has the capability to send and receive key clinical information.

To send key clinical information, the user first generates a "Health Information Summary" for the patient from the EHR reports menu.



The Health Information Summary includes the following key clinical information as defined by the MU

requirements:


- Problem List
- Medication Allergies
- Medication History
- Immunization History
- Diagnostic Test Results

Once the summary is generated, the user responds to the dialog box below:

To email the summary as an electronic Continuity of Care Document (CCD), this option is selected in the "Output Options". The email address and CCD-access password are entered and clicking "OK" will send the Health Information Summary electronically to the email address specified.

PCC EHR can also electronically receive key clinical information for patients. Once a patient chart is open, the user would access a patient's Continuity of Care documents under the "Reports" menu.



Once the electronic CCD has been received from the facility and placed in the appropriate shared directory on the client server, the file can be imported into the patient chart and shown in an archived list of documents as shown in the screen shot below:
